Instructions for Participants

- Select a poem that is catchy, age appropriate and resonates with your emotions and style. It can be funny or serious, happy or sad, or something else altogether.
- Poetry is a form of theatre. Bring the poem to life with the right tone, rhythm, pitch and emphasis. Engage with the audience, use your gestures and movements to enhance your message.
- Make sure you memorize the piece so that you can deliver it with fluency and clarity.
- You will be judged on your expressions, intonation, fluency, clarity, accuracy, voice modulation and overall impact.
- Please submit a printed copy of your poem for the judges' perusal.
