

- Identifying and explaining presentational features, language features, punctuation, figures of speech, atmosphere, mood and tone in texts
- Identifying audience/purpose of texts
- Sequencing ideas, events in the correct order.
- Summarizing key ideas

Writing: Questions will focus on spellings, grammar, and creative writing.

- Comparison of ideas, themes, poets' viewpoints
- Explanation of poetic features with evidence

The following poetic features in particular can be studied:

a) Onomatopoeia

b) Simile

c) Metaphor

d) Personification

e) Alliteration

f) Rhyme

g) Poet's use of language, form and structure to create effect

h) Descriptive and narrative effects

i) Personal responses and preferences, supported by reference to poems

Accurate use of grammar, spelling and punctuation will also be considered.


